Napa Community Animal Response Team (Napa CART) is a volunteer organization that works in cooperation with local agencies to ensure the best possible outcome for animals in Napa County and other areas who need assistance during an emergency, accident or disaster.

Our three-fold mission is to (1) educate the public on the animal component of disaster preparedness, response and recovery (2) assist Emergency Services in sheltering, evacuation and care of animals during a disaster and (3) provide ongoing training in animal rescue and trauma care to first responders, veterinary professionals and community volunteers.

To become a Disaster Service Worker (DSW) with Napa CART and eligible for activation in an emergency, you must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Create a profile on <u>Better Impact</u>. Or though our website: <u>napacart.org/volunteer/volunteer-application</u>
 - a. Be sure to read and sign the Code of Conduct and Volunteer Liability Release
- 2. Complete the New Volunteer Orientation via Zoom on Friday March 28th (sign up through Better Impact!)
- 3. Complete CERT training: www.countyofnapa.org/362/Community-Emergency-Response-Team-CERT
- 4. Complete the following FEMA Online Courses: IS 100 and IS 200: training.fema.gov/is
- 5. Pass a Background Check. An invitation will be emailed to you once you have completed the above requirements.
